Degrees, Certificates and Continuing Education

THE Associate in Arts (A.A.) Degree

The A.A. prepares students to enter a four-year baccalaureate program within the Florida State University System or State College System. The program contains 60 credit hours of general education and elective study. Students may enter at the start of any semester and class times are convenient for full or part-time students. THE Associate in Science (A.S.) and Associate in Applied Science (A.A.S) Degrees

The A.S. and A.A.S. degrees prepare students to enter a new career, or enhance current work skills. The Associate in Science programs range from 60-72 credit hours. For more information, contact an A.S. Advisor by referring to the facing page on the left or visiting fkcc.edu.

Continuing Education Non-Credit Classes (Shorter in length and convenient)

Through the Office of Continuing Education, FKCC offers non-credit courses in the areas of recreation and leisure, lifelong learning and workforce education. Call the Continuing Education Office at 305-809-3185.

Steps to Becoming an FKCC Student

Step 1 Apply for Admission to FKCC- Complete and submit an FKCC Application for Admission. \$30 application fee.

Step 2 Request Transcripts- Have your official college or high school transcripts sent to FKCC's Office of Enrollment Services.

Step 3 Take a Placement Test- To enroll in a degree program and/or college-level English or math courses, you must take the College Entry-Level Placement Test (CPT). FKCC will accept SAT or ACT scores in lieu of the CPT scores that are no more than two years old.



Step 4 Apply for Financial Aid & Scholarships- Need help financing your education? Don't wait until the last minute to apply for aid.

If you are applying for aid for the Spring Term, submit your FAFSA (Federal Application for Student Aid) by **November 20th** to allow adequate time for processing and verifications, which must be complete before the payment due of December 18, 2009 in order to have your tuition/fees deferred.

Step 5 Register for Classes- FKCC Advising Services can assist you in selecting the best courses to meet your educational, professional and personal goals. First-time in college students, who are degree-seeking, must register with an advisor. Call Advising Services for an appointment: 305-809-3196. Your Academic Advisor will provide guidance as to your academic options. Your advisor will explain your placement test scores, review your program degree requirements, help you create a course schedule and advise you about transferring and career opportunities.

Step 6 Attend Orientation- Orientation is required for new FKCC degree-seeking students. The Orientation sessions provide important information, and offer fun social activities where students acclimate to student life.

Avoid Being Dropped from Classes, Pay All Your Tuition & Fees On Time

Scholarships and financial aid such as Bright Futures, Florida Pre-Paid, Board of Trustee Scholarships, College Explorer Scholarships, Pell Grants & Loans do not always cover 100% of your tuition and fees. You may have an outstanding balance after your aid is applied to your bill. **STUDENTS MUST PAY ALL TUITION and FEES by December 18, 2009 to avoid being dropped from classes.** A \$25 reinstatement fee will be applied when you re-register.
